



YOU MUST DECIDE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING OCCURANCES PLAYED ON A REGULATION SIZE FIELD, SHOULD THE GAME BE STOPPED, AND IF SO WHAT WOULD THE PROPER RESTART BE.

No Stoppage Necessary-NS
Kick-Off/Place Kick-KO
Dropped Ball-DB
Throw-In-TI
Goal Kick-GK
Corner Kick-CK
Direct Free Kick-DFK
Indirect Free Kick-IFK
Penalty Kick-PK

1. FROM A THROW-IN, THE BALL GOES DIRECTLY INTO THE OPPONENTS GOAL WITHOUT BEING TOUCHED BY ANOTHER PLAYER.
2. AFTER A GOAL-KICK HAS BEEN TAKEN, THE BALL STRIKES THE REFEREE INSIDE THE PENALTY-AREA, AND, THEN CONTINUES OVER THE TOUCH-LINE.
3. A PLAYER TAKES A THROW-IN WHILE STANDING WITH BOTH OF HIS HEELS ON THE TOUCH-LINE WITH HIS TOES IN THE FIELD OF PLAY. THE BALL CROSSES THE OPPONENT GOAL-LINE WITHOUT IT TOUCHING ANYONE ELSE.
4. FROM A DROPPED-BALL, AFTER THE BALL TOUCHES THE GROUND, A PLAYER KICKS AND THEN, WITHOUT ANY OTHER PLAYER TOUCHING IT, KICKS THE BALL AGAIN, DIRECTLY INTO HIS OPPONENTS GOAL.
5. FROM A GOAL-KICK, A PLAYER TAKING THE KICK, ATTEMPS TO PASS THE BALL TO A TEAM AT ONE SIDE OF THE PENALTY-AREA. THE BALL CROSSES THE GOAL-LINE AT A POINT 10 YARDS FROM THE GOAL-POST.
6. THE GOALKEEPER SPRINTS FROM THE GOAL TO STOP THE OPPONENTS ATTACKER BUT SUCCEEDS ONLY IN CLEARING THE BALL AWAY FROM THE FIELD-OF-PLAY OVER THE TOUCH LINE. BECAUSE OF HIS SPEED, THE GOALKEEPERS MOMENTUM CARRIES HIM OFF THE FIELD. THE ATTACKER EXPLOITS THE SITUATION BY TAKING A THROW-IN QUICKLY AND CORRECTLY, WITH THE GOALKEEPER STILL OFF THE FIELD, AND ENDS WITH A GOAL BEING SCORED.
7. A PENALTY-KICK REBOUNDS OFF THE GOAL-POST DIRECTLY BACK TO THE KICKER WHO THEN KICKS THE BALL OVER THE TOP OF THE CROSSBAR.
8. A COACH ENTERS THE FIELD OF PLAY, DURING THE GAME, WITHOUT THE REFEREE'S PERMISSION.
9. A SUBSTITUTE ENTERS THE FIELD OF PLAY, DURING THE GAME, WITHOUT THE REFEREE'S PERMISSION.
10. AN ATTACKER TAKES A SHOT ON GOAL DURING NORMAL PLAY. BEFORE THE BALL CAN ENTER THE GOAL A SPECTATOR RUNS ONTO THE FIELD OF PLAY AND TOUCHES THE BALL TRYING TO PREVENT A GOAL. THE SPECTATOR IS UNSUCCESSFUL AND THE BALL ENTERS THE GOAL.

11. AN ATTACKER SHOOTS THE BALL TOWARD THE GOAL. THE DEFENDER ON THE GOAL-LINE, OTHER THAN THE GOALKEEPER, ATTEMPS TO PREVENT THE BALL FROM ENTERING THE GOAL BY HANDLING THE BALL. THE BALL DEFLECTS OFF THE DEFENDER'S HAND AND ENTERS THE GOAL.
12. AN INDIRECT FREE KICK IS AWARDED TO THE ATTACKING TEAM OUTSIDE THE OPPONENT'S PENALTY AREA. THE REFEREE FAILS TO RAISE HIS ARM TO INDICATE THAT THE KICK IS INDIRECT AND THE BALL IS KICKED DIRECTLY INTO THE GOAL.
13. A PLAYER, AFTER TAKING A GOAL KICK PLAYED THE BALL A SECOND TIME BEFORE IT HAS CLEARED THE PENALTY AREA.
14. FROM AN INDIRECT FREE KICK TAKEN INSIDE THE PENALTY AREA, A PLAYER KICKS THE BALL INTO HIS OWN GOAL.
15. FROM A CORNER KICK, THE BALL REBOUNDS OFF A GOAL POST DIRECTLY BACK TO THE PLAYER WHO TOOK THE CORNER KICK AND HE THEN KICKS THE BALL OVER THE GOAL LINE.
16. FROM A FREE KICK TAKEN OUTSIDE THE PENALTY AREA, A PLAYER KICKS THE BALL DIRECTLY INTO HIS OWN GOAL.
17. AT THE TAKING OF A PENALTY KICK A TEAMMATE OF THE KICKER ENTERS THE PENALTY AREA BEFORE THE KICK IS TAKEN AND THE BALL ENTERS THE GOAL.
18. AT THE TAKING OF A PENALTY KICK A TEAMMATE OF THE KICKER ENTERS THE PENALTY AREA BEFORE THE KICK IS TAKEN AND THE BALL IS DEFLECTED OVER THE CROSS BAR BY THE GOALKEEPER.
19. A PLAYER SPITS ON A TEAMMATE WHILE THE BALL IS IN PLAY.
20. A DEFENDER, IN A RECKLESS MANNER, TRIPS AN ATTACKER OUTSIDE THE DEFENDER'S PENALTY AREA, BUT INSIDE THE PENALTY ARC.
21. AT A KICKOFF A PLAYER RUNS INTO THE OPPONENT'S HALF BEFORE THE BALL IS KICKED FORWARD AND RECEIVES THE BALL NEAR THE TOUCH LINE.
22. AT THE TAKING OF A PENALTY KICK THE KICKER APPROACHES THE BALL AND SLIPS JUST AS HE IS ABOUT TO KICK THE BALL. AS HE IS FALLING HE MANAGES TO KICK THE BALL SLIGHTLY FORWARD. AN ALERT TEAMMATE IN AN ON-SIDE POSITION RUNS IN AND KICKS THE BALL INTO THE GOAL.
23. AS THE GOALKEEPER CATCHES AND MAINTAINS CONTROL OF THE BALL, INSIDE HIS GOAL-AREA, HE INJURES HIMSELF. THE GAME IS STOPPED TO ALLOW A TRAINER TO ATTEND TO THE GOALKEEPER.
24. THE REFEREE CALLS A FOUL OUTSIDE THE PENALTY AREA BECAUSE A DEFENDER MADE THEIRSELF BIGGER AND THE BALL WHEN KICKED BY AN ATTACKER TO THEIR TEAMMATE MADE CONTACT WITH THE DEFENDERS HAND OR ARM.
25. THE REFEREE EVALUATES AN AERIAL CHALLENGE BETWEEN TWO OPPONENTS AS ONE OF THEM IS LEADING WITH AN ELBOW AT THE OPPONENT WITH RECKLESS FORCE.

ANSWER THE FOLLOWING AS TRUE OR FALSE

26. AT A CORNER KICK, OPPONENTS MUST REMAIN 10 YARDS FROM THE BALL.
27. THE REFEREE CAN ONLY CAUTION A SUBSTITUTE OR SUBSTITUTED PLAYER FOR THE FOLLOWING THREE OFFENSES (A) GUILTY OF UNSPORTING BEHAVIOR, (B) SHOWS DISSENT BY WORD OR ACTION, (C) DELAYS THE RESTART OF PLAY.
28. AT THE TAKING OF A PENALTY KICK A TEAM-MATE OF THE KICKER ENTERS THE PENALTY AREA BEFORE THE KICK IS TAKEN. THE KICK IS TAKEN AND MISSED. THE RESTART IS TAKEN WHERE THE BALL WAS WHEN THE PLAYER ENTERED THE PENALTY AREA.
29. THE COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT FOR A PLAYER CAN INCLUDE A ONE PIECE UNIFORM. SUCH AS HIS/HER JERSEY AND SHORTS JOINED TOGETHER.
30. A DEFENDING PLAYER MAY BE CAUTIONED FOR UNSPORTING BEHAVIOR WHEN NOT STANDING 2 YARDS FROM A THROW IN.
31. THE USE OF ELBOWS IS CONSIDERED A FORM OF STRIKING AND MUST BE RESTARTED WITH A DIRECT FREE KICK.
32. WHEN THE USE OF ELBOWS IS JUDGED BY THE REFEREE TO BE WITH EXCESSIVE FORCE THE REFEREE MUST SEND OFF THE PLAYER AND SHOW THE RED CARD.
33. A REFEREE MAY NOT SHOW YELLOW OR RED CARDS AT THE HALF OR AFTER THE MATCH IS FINISHED.
34. A PLAYER BLEEDING FROM A WOUND MUST LEAVE THE FIELD OF PLAY AND MAY NOT RETURN UNTIL THE REFEREE IS SATISFIED THE BLEEDING HAS STOPPED.
35. REFEREES SHOULD BE ALERT AT ALL TIMES TO PLAYERS WHO PERSISTENTLY INFRINGE THE LAWS. EVEN IF A PLAYER COMMITS A NUMBER OF DIFFERENT OFFENSES, THE PLAYER MUST STILL BE CAUTIONED FOR PERSISTENTLY INFRINGING THE LAWS.
36. ANY TACKLE WHICH ENDANGERS THE SAFETY OF AN OPPONENT MUST BE SANCTIONED AS SERIOUS FOUL PLAY.
37. VIOLENT CONDUCT MAY OCCUR EITHER ON THE FIELD OF PLAY OR OUTSIDE ITS BOUNDARIES, WHETHER THE BALL IS IN PLAY OR NOT.
38. WHEN THE REFEREE REALIZES THAT HE/SHE HAS MADE AN INCORRECT DECISION, THE REFEREE MAY CHANGE THAT DECISION REGARDLESS OF WHETHER PLAY HAS RESTARTED OR NOT.
39. IN THE DEFINITION OF OFFSIDE POSITION, "NEARER TO THE OPPONENTS GOAL LINE" MEANS THAT ANY PART OF THE PLAYERS HEAD, BODY OR FEET IS NEARER TO THE OPPONENTS GOAL LINE THAN BOTH THE BALL AND THE SECOND LAST DEFENDER. THE ARMS ARE INCLUDED IN THIS DEFINITION.
40. A DEFENSIVE PLAYER IS GUILTY OF A CAUTIONABLE OR SENDING OFF OFFENCE, BUT THE REFEREE ALLOWS PLAY TO CONTINUE TO GIVE AN ADVANTAGE TO THE OPPOSING TEAM. THE PLAYER MAY BE CAUTIONED OR SENT OFF AT ANY TIME AFTER THAT.
